Dear North Enfield,

The 2022 season will soon be upon us, and the committee at NECC are keen to ensure our club continues to prosper on and off the field. Following a record number of Sunday XI fixtures in 2021, we hope to provide even more opportunities for players young and old to represent our club. To do this we need the help and assistance of every player, parent and friend to put their hand up and continue volunteering their time and effort – the more we can all do, the stronger we, as a club, become.

We expect to have a full season of Adult and Junior cricket ahead, and our Juniors Coordinator (Nick Munt) is currently collating our age groups, league fixtures and training group sizes for the summer ahead. The youth section is absolutely vital for the financial security and prosperity of the club – so even if you're not a parent/guardian please consider coming along for a social drink on a Wednesday evening and/or when a Junior home fixture takes place. All support and encouragement is welcome whilst our future stars hone their skills.

As always, for NECC to balance the books, we require our members to pay an annual subscription fee. This is my third season as Membership Secretary, and I've made a few minor tweaks to the fee structure I inherited. These are all intended to balance fairness and accessibility with our financial needs, and the key change to highlight this year is a new "Social Player" membership category which is designed to allow both existing and new infrequent/occasional players to participate without contributing the same as a Full member. Many of us have family, work and other life commitments which make playing every week impossible, so I hope this new category can benefit those who play infrequently (and those who wish to give cricket a go at a later age, as I myself did).

The other changes to flag are that Junior membership is for participants of Wednesday training only (which is U15 and below this season), and Social Membership is a simplified £10 per person (rather than £20 per couple). Anyone under the age of 21 (as of 1st Sep 2021) and not involved in Wednesday training is now classed as a Young Adult/Student, along with any member in full time further education.

With the above clarified, I can confirm our 2022 prices are as follows:

Adult Full Membership = **£130** (includes Social for partner)

Adult New Member (first season at NECC) = **£65**

Young Adult (U21)/Student = **£55**

Social Player (participation in up to 6 Adult matches) = **£65**

Social Membership = **£10** (per individual)

Junior Member = **£90** (includes Social for up to 2 parents/guardians)

(note: Reduced fee of **£65** applies for Full Adult/Social Player/Life Member/Vice President son/daughter)

Siblings of Junior Members = **£55** each
