



Changing Rooms and Showering Facilities Policy

Statement of Intent

The aim of this policy is to provide procedures and practical guidance for all members and officials of North Enfield Cricket Club to safeguard juniors (meaning all persons under the age of 18yrs) and mixed gender teams during changing and showering activities.

Policy

Juniors and adults should not use the same changing facilities at the same time. Best practice principles are to be adopted, wherever possible, are as follows:

- Adults must not change or shower at the same time using the same facility as children - if the same changing room is used then they must have different times
- Mixed gender teams must have access to separate male and female changing rooms
- Due to the risks of inappropriate photography or filming, mobile phones must not be used in changing rooms
- If juniors are uncomfortable changing or showering at the club, no pressure should be placed on them to do so. Suggest instead that they may change and shower at home
- Adults not involved in a supervisory capacity (including parents) must not enter any changing rooms during match days and training sessions unless explicitly requested to do so by someone in a supervisory capacity
- Parents of juniors playing in open age teams will be informed of the clubs changing room and showering facilities policy

Consequences Of not following this policy

Any member found to be in breach of the above Policy may be subject to disciplinary action by the Club (up to and including cancellation of Club membership).
