



## Health & Safety Policy

North Enfield Cricket Club is strongly committed to ensuring the health, well-being and safety of our members while undertaking all cricket related activities.

To support our Health & Safety policy statement we are committed to the following duties:

- Undertake regular, recorded risk assessment of the club premises and all activities undertaken by the club
- Create a safe environment by putting health & safety measures in place as identified by the assessment
- Ensure that all members are given the appropriate level of training and competition by regularly assessing individual ability dependant on age, maturity and development
- Ensure that all members are aware of, understand and follow the club's health & safety policy
- Appoint a competent club member to assist with health and safety responsibilities
- Ensure that normal operating procedures and emergency operating procedures are in place and known by all members
- Provide access to adequate first aid facilities, telephone and qualified first aider at all times
- Report any injuries or accidents sustained during any club activity or whilst on the club premises
- Ensure that the implementation of the policy is reviewed regularly and monitored for effectiveness.

All members have a duty of care to:

- Take reasonable care for your own health & safety and that of others who may be affected by what you do or not do
- Co-operate with the club on health & safety issues
- Correctly use all equipment provided by the club
- Not interfere with or misuse anything provided for your health, safety or welfare.

## First Aid and Emergency Procedure

- First aid boxes are located in the juniors store room and kitchen
- Please ensure that the accident book (also located in the room) is filled in when an incident occurs
- Access to the grounds can be made via the security gate. Padlock key can be found in the key store entitled 'Grounds Access gate'.

If any of the equipment from the first aid box is used, please report this to North Enfield Cricket Club Welfare Officer (Nick Munt), so that it can be replenished
