We are now less than a week away from the return of junior training sessions, and (weather-permitting) the senior season for 2024. This means your annual membership subscription is now payable.

As mentioned at the AGM, our club is reliant on membership and matchday income from our members. Striking a fair balance is an annual challenge, and the committee hopes to cover a proportion of increased ground preparation costs, general maintenance and longer-term investment through levying Sunday friendly opposition hosting fees, additional club social events and ideally managing more clubhouse hires than in recent years. With this in mind, we are able to avoid an increase in membership or match costs for this season.

Our prices for 2024 are therefore unchanged from 2023 and are as follows:

Adult Full Membership = **£145** (includes Social for partner)

Adult New Member (first season at NECC) = **£72.50**

Young Adult (U21)/Student = **£70**

Social Player (participation in up to 6 Adult matches) = **£72.50**

Social Membership = **£15** (per individual)

Junior Member = **£105** (includes Social for up to 2 parents/guardians)

(note: Reduced fee of **£75** applies for Full Adult/Social Player/Life Member/Vice President son/daughter)

Siblings of Junior Members = **£65** each

**Match fees are due on the same day the match is played!**

Adult Cricket Match Fees: £13 for Adults/Social Player, £7.00 for all others

Special/Social Match Fees (e.g. T20 games): £7 for Adults/Social Player, £4 for all others
